We sincerely appreciate your continued support. Following last year's initiative, we are pleased to report on our “Kuroshio Smile Activity,” a school supplies donation program implemented in the Philippines.

This activity is part of our SDGs initiative, “Charity for the Countries that Provide Our Seafarers”, and marks its third consecutive year.

The “Kuroshio Smile Activity” aims to express our gratitude to our Filipino seafarers working on our managed vessels, while also improving the educational environment for schools and students in their residential areas and hometowns where support is often lacking. This year, we visited the following three elementary schools, with our company executives also participating in the visit to Tungkay Elementary School.

 - Makatol Elementary School
- **Contents to be provided:**
 - Stationery Set (Pens, Pencils, Erasers, Crayons, etc.)
 - Electric Fan
 - Water Dispenser
 - Printer
 - Raincoat
 - Backpack
 - Hand Fan
 - Donated Items from Our Stakeholders
- **Beneficiary:** Approximately 550 students in total

The above three schools were introduced to us by the families of seafarers working in our company.

This year, Cebu Island experienced severe flooding and numerous landslides due to a magnitude 6.9 earthquake on September 30th and the landfall of Typhoon Kalmaegi (Typhoon No. 25). During our visit, we could see evidence of damaged houses and landslides everywhere.

Despite the busy recovery efforts, we received a heartwarming and enthusiastic welcome that day. Witnessing the pure smiles of the students when they received the donated items deeply moved us. Furthermore, continuing from last year, our partner manning companies and seafarers on leave in the area actively supported the activities by transporting the donated items and arranging vehicles, allowing us to further strengthen our solid relationship of trust with them. We truly feel that it is only through the tremendous efforts of the seafarers that we can continue this activity.

We would like to express our heartfelt gratitude to all the companies that provided school supplies and other materials for this activity.
