This activity is a part of our SDGs activities, "Charity for the Countries that Provide Seafarers".

The "Kuroshio Smile Activity" aims to support the educational environment for poor children in the regions where our seafarers work as an expression of our gratitude to the seafarers who work on our managed vessels and to raise awareness of the regions where they come from. This year, we visited two elementary schools as follows

Summary of Activities

- **Date**: December 4 and 5, 2024
- Place: Caticlan, Panay Island, Philippines
 - Magallanes Elementary School
 - Union Elementary School
- Contents to be provided:
 - School supply sets (notebooks, pens, pencils, erasers, bags, etc.)
 - Television Set
 - Electronic fans
 - Water server
 - Uniforms (Magallanes Elementary School only)
 - Contributions from our Stakeholders
- Beneficiary: Approximately 840 students in total

According to local teachers and staff, this was the first time a Japanese company had visited an elementary school and provided school supplies since the school opened. We received a heartwarming and enthusiastic welcome on the day of the visit and seeing the pure and innocent smiles on the children's faces when they received the school supplies was an irreplaceable memory for us. In addition, as in the previous year, our crew members on leave who live in the same area actively supported our activities by providing transportation and other assistance, and we were able to deepen our relationship of trust with them.
